Our Parent Involvement Policy contains the following components:

- Parents will receive information throughout the school year from regular meetings, parent/teacher conferences, monthly calendar of events, home visits, phone calls, interim reports, report cards, and parent volunteer programs.
- A student/parent/teacher accountability contract is sent home that outlines how parents, students, teachers, and the entire school will share the responsibility for improving student achievement.
- An annual assessment of our school's parent involvement policy will be completed each year by parents to determine the effectiveness of the program and make improvements if needed.
